



COVID-19 – LIMITS ON LIBRARY SERVICES

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the following library policies will be in effect until, March 31, 2021, unless extended or terminated by the Board of Trustees. These supersede any existing library policies.

1. While in the building, patrons must wear masks that fully cover the mouth and nose. If they do not have a mask, the library will provide them with a disposable mask. If they are unable to wear a mask, library staff will provide curbside service if it can be done safely.
2. In order to enter the building, patrons should wash hands or use hand sanitizer at the entrance.
3. Patrons must comply with social distancing guidelines. Those who refuse to do so may be required to leave by the Library Director or his/her designee.
4. Some areas of the building may be designated off-limits to library patrons.
5. Patron access to the library building may be limited to one hour per day.
6. Computer use may be limited to one hour per day.
7. Some regular library services may be limited or suspended.
8. Due to the mask requirement, patrons may not consume food or drink inside the library.
9. For the time being, meeting rooms may not be reserved by outside groups. In addition, no public gatherings are permitted inside the library until such time as social distancing requirements have been lifted.
